*Note

Participants can choose to make an oral or poster presentation in the registration form. However, the final assignment will be decided by the BSS committee. Presentation and poster assignments can be found on the 20th BSS program booklet, which will be sent to the participants at a later time.

6. Evaluation and Award

Oral presentation

- **Award:**
25,000 yen/winner (1 winner from each oral session)
- **Evaluation**
2 senior professors from GSB and 3 professors outside of the GSB

Poster presentation

- **Judges Award:**
20,000 yen for 1st place, 15,000 yen for 2nd place, and 10,000 yen for 3rd place
- **Audience Award:**
20,000 yen for 1st place, 15,000 yen for 2nd place, and 10,000 yen for 3rd place
- **Evaluation**
15 junior faculty members from GSB or Kyoto University and audience vote
